



Local business helps four legged Ike victims

PARIS, Ill. (WTHI) - Thousands of pets are now without homes in the state of Texas because of hurricane Ike.

For that reason the Houston Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals is reaching out to Wabash Valley residents.

A Paris, Illinois based company called Dog Lover's Choice Extra Topping will donate bottles of their all natural dog food supplement to the Houston group.

So, one of the easiest ways to get the dog out of stress is to get them back on food and get 'em eating."
